

Commercial Construction Process

Permit Fee:

- Building permit fee is based on project valuation.
- 25% of the permit fee must be paid when plans are submitted. The remaining fee can be paid at submittal or at time of issuance.
- The utility estimate will be provided prior to issuance of the permit.

Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (TCO):

- Fee for TCO request is 25% of the permit fee.
- Safety & ADA issues must be satisfied prior to issuance of certification.
- A formal written request must be submitted for approval for a TCO.

Pre-submittal Meetings:

- Pre-submittal meetings are required for all project types over \$1,000,000.00. (optional under \$1,000,000.00 if requested)
- Plans, valuation, address, contact information, project type (new, addition, alteration), and meeting type (in person/teleconference) must be emailed to <u>inspectionreguest@lascruces.gov</u>
- Plans must be 90% complete.
- There must be a valid address for the location.

Review Timeline:

- Valuation \$0 \$50,000
- Valuation \$50,001 \$100,000
- Valuation over \$101,000
- 3 business days 5 business davs
- 8 business days

Required Documents:

- Signed contract btw permittee and property owner with proof of ownership.
- Site Plan
- Construction Drawings
