Overview

Statutory Deadlines

- September 1
 - ✓ Issuing producer licenses
- January 1
 - ✓ All other licenses
- April 1, 2022
 - Retail sales to begin

Available Applications

- Available online for: producer, producer microbusiness, manufacturer, retailer, courier, vertically integrated cannabis establishment and integrated cannabis microbusiness
- ccd.rld.state.nm.us

Subsequent Applications

- Cannabis consumption areas, cannabis server permits and cannabis education and training programs
- Applications for other license types by January 1

Licensing and Fees

LICENSE	PROPOSED FEES
Courier	\$250 / \$100 per premise
Testing Laboratory	\$2,500 / \$1,000 per premise
Manufacturer	\$2,500 / \$1,000 per premise
Producer	\$2,500 / \$1,000 per premise
Retailer	\$2,500 / \$1,000 per premise
Research Laboratory	\$2,500 / \$1,000 per premise
Vertically Integrated Cannabis Establishment	\$7,500 / \$1,000 per premise
Cannabis Producer Microbusiness	100 plants or less: \$500 101 to 200 plants: \$1,000
Integrated Cannabis Microbusiness	Activity based: \$1,000 - \$2,500
Cannabis Consumption Area	\$2,500

Plant Fees



Plant Fees

Proposed per plant fees apply to licenses pertaining to producers EXCEPT producer microbusinesses and integrated cannabis microbusinesses.

Proposed fee structure is based on the number of plants:

Level #	Number of Plants	Per Plant Fee (Adult Use)	Per Plant Fee (Medical)
1	201 – 1,000	\$10	\$5
2	1,001 – 3,000		
3	3,001 – 6,000		
4	6,001 – 8,000

Requirements Once Licensed

- Grow requirements
- Health and safety
- Security

Online Application

- General personal and business information (contact information, business license, operations, distance from schools and daycares)
- Land requirements (water usage)
- Proposed grow (number of plants)
- Diagram of premises
- Certifications and attestations*
