Inspection Process

Permit information:

- Work may commence once the permit is issued.
- Permits are valid for 180 days, inspections are verification that work is continuous. The permit is extended for 180 days after each inspection not to exceed 1 year.
- Each discipline is required to obtain permit (Building, Mechanical, Plumbing, and Electrical) and must have the license credentials from the State of New Mexico.
- The permit holder (licensed professional) is the only person that may request inspection for their specific discipline.

Development Phase:

 Inspections are required to ensure that the project complies with the approved plans, all rules and regulations governing construction, and life safety requirements are met.

- Low Voltage

- Inspections should only be requested when ready.

Building Inspection types:

- Foundation/Concrete Frame -Lath -Final
- Driveway/Sidewalk -Deck roof -Insulation

Mechanical Inspection types:

- Rough In - Final

Plumbing Inspection types:

- Rough in Top Out
- Gas Piping Yard Line
- Final

Electrical Inspection types:

- Temporary Service Underground
 - Rough In
 - Final
