

FIGHT F.O.G.

Keep fats, oils & grease from clogging sewer pipes and storm drain systems.



- Don't pour cooking grease, oils or fats down the drain. Place used grease, oils and fats in a rendering tank for recycling.
- Drain screens keep solid food and debris out of the plumbing and sewer system. Food waste should be placed in the garbage or in a compost system.
- Wash floor mats in a utility sink. Do not hose down floors or parking areas. Run-off associated with cleaning activities is a violation of the Clean Water Act and local storm water ordinances.
- Use kitty litter to absorb liquid spills. Use a broom to sweep up used litter and place in a trash receptacle.
- Scrape and wipe off dishes, pots, pans and utensils before washing and rinsing.
- Repair and replace leaky dumpsters. Do not remove dumpster plug
- Empty grease containers before they are full. Provide employees with the proper training for grease disposal and clean-up.
